INSTRUCTION

Read the travel guide about Sopot to practise and improve your reading skills.

Whether you are travelling to the Black Sea coast or the mountains of Bulgaria, you have to spend at least an hour or two in Sopot on the way. Located 5 km from Karlovo, at the foot of the impressive Balkan Mountain, Sopot plays an important role in the cultural development and history of Bulgaria. Sopot might be small but it is still an exciting town with lots of things to see and do.

Where to stay

One of the most comfortable hotels in this historical Bulgarian town is the Home Land Hotel, where we definitely recommend you to stay. The hotel is located in the town center. It has a wonderful garden where you can enjoy your time. The hotel offers a nice playing area for children and a piano bar with a charming atmosphere for adults, free Wi Fi and a private car park. The hotel provides single and double rooms with pleasant balconies as well as little family apartments with cosy kitchens. The prices are very reasonable, as you need only about 20 euros for a double room.

What to do

The town provides excellent conditions for entertainment and pleasant activities. If you like sport, you can play tennis at the nice tennis court or go cycling. If you are fond of nature, you can go fishing in the river or go for a walk or hiking in the mountain area that surrounds the town. One of the most interesting tourist attractions in Sopot are Rada's school, the house of the Bulgarian writer and poet Ivan Vazov and the girl monastery "Vavedenie Bogorodichno" – "The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary".

Where to eat

After having gone sightseeing you will need somewhere to eat. We recommend you the "The Old House" tavern. They have a rich menu and cook delicious traditional dishes. On warm days, they have a cozy garden where you can enjoy a peaceful and pleasant atmosphere.
